Through the use of conspiracy theories and fake news, the Commission has found that hateful extremists have used divisive, xenophobic and racist narratives to sow division and undermine the social fabric of our country. They are also concerned that extremists will capitalise on any post COVID socio-economic turmoil to cause division and fear in British society.
